Olivia Schulze-Lecerf is a Trade Policy Adviser at the Swedish National Board of Trade, where she contributes to the development of EU trade policy with a particular focus on regulatory cooperation. She brings over a decade of experience in international trade, regulatory affairs, and public policy, spanning both the public and private sectors.

Before joining the Board, Olivia spent ten years at H&M Group, where she built and led the company's global trade and customs function. Her work focused on optimizing supply chain flows, navigating complex regulatory environments, and influencing trade-related policymaking. She also played a key role in shaping the company's public affairs agenda in Sweden and globally. Earlier in her career, Olivia held various policy roles at the European Commission in Brussels, including in the Directorate-General for Research and Innovation and on interinstitutional relations with the European Parliament.
