



Allan Larsson has had a career as a journalist, Undersecretary of Labour, Director General of the Swedish Labour Market Board, Finance Minister, Member of Parliament, Director General of the EU Commission, chairman of Swedish Television and Lund University and a member of international commissions and advisory boards. He is currently involved in climate city development projects; he is founder and senior adviser in ElectricITY/Hammarby Sjöstad, former chair of the national innovation program Viable Cities and former vice chair of EU Mission Board on climate neutral cities.

Allan Larsson was born April 3, 1938 in Bredaryd in Southern Sweden. After University studies in Lund he became a journalist, working as news reporter for Arbetet, Aftonbladet, Dagens Nyheter and Swedish Television and editor-in-chief of a weekly magazine, Vi.
